NIAS Update

Our first Regional Training Session was held on the 20FEB21 in Tamworth. All 14 athletes attended. The second Regional Training Session on the 20MAR21 was cancelled due to wet weather. The NIAS Education weekend was held on the 27-28MAR21. The weekend incorporated much of Regional Training Session 2's skills and riding. The third Regional Training Session set for the slopes of Borah was moved to Manilla Showground. The fourth Regional Training Session was held at Inverell MTB Park. After sun salutations and a warm-up, athletes practised a few core skills on the unique Inverell surface.

Five athletes attended the RTE SuperFlow event at Awaba. Results include: 21st in U13s, 8th and 60th in U15s, and 49th and 55th in U17s.

Two athletes attended the NEMTB Club Champs on the 25APR21. Both riders went on to win their categories with Kalean named Club Champion of U15s.

At the Awaba RTE GP, NIAS athlete Kaden Thisle rode with John Reynolds (JetBlack MTB Racing) to place 3rd in their category. Five riders attended the RTE GP event at Glenrock. Results include: 1st and 3rd in U15s 4hr Team and 1st in U18 4hr Solo.

NEMTB Mother's Day event NIAS brought four riders and all their parents. Andy rode in a team with his dad and scored the Annual Trophy.

Seven athletes attended the NIXCS Round 1 at SportUNE. Results include 2nd, 4th and 5th in U17s, 2nd in U15s and 1st, 2nd and 3rd in U13s. Seven athletes attended the NIXCS Round 2 at Inverell. Results include 2nd, 4th and 6th in U17s, 1st in U15s and 1st, 2nd and 3rd in U13s.

Three riders attended the Hunter Schools event at Glenrock. Results include U13s XCO 2nd and 3rd, in the GE a 5th and 6th. In U17s 2nd in XCO and 5th in GE.

The fifth Regional Training Session was due to be held at Armidale but due to weather it was moved to Tamworth and indoors for four hours of off-bike but cycle specific training.

At the RTE SuperFlow Jollynose results include 7th U13s, 8th and 12th U15s.

Five riders attended the NIXCS Round 3 at Walcha. Results include 1st, 2nd and 4th in U17s, 1st in U15s and 1st in U13s.

Ten NIAS athletes attended the RTE GP Jollynose event. Results include 1st, 2nd and 3rd in U15s Pairs, 1st and 3rd in U18s solo, Harrison teamed up with Coach Alyssa to place 4th and Kaden teamed up with Coach Crummy to place 2nd.

Seven riders attended the RTE GP Kempsey. Results include 1st and 2nd in U15s Pairs, 1st in U18s solo. Harrison and Coach Alyssa in 3nd, Campbell teamed up with Trainee Coach Lachlan to place 1st.

Riders are being encouraged to attend their local club events, while considering the out-of-region events. The coaching staff will be keeping a keen eye on the new athletes weekly via these events, particularly TAMMTB, Inverell and NEMTB over the next month.
