Weed Management: See attachment

Fleabane (see attachment photo) - the tall weed with white flowers has infiltrated our trails. Unfortunately the roundup treatment when it was in the rosette stage hasn't worked well. Brush cutting only lasts a couple of weeks before it is back tall again. We really need to control this weed.

I have spoken to a numbers of experts (TRC; private weed sprayers) and they have recommend a couple of herbicide mixtures (which we have) that should work. I intend to do a sample spray with the two different 'brews' to see which works the best.

Jeff to try "Slasher" or Seasol Organic spray from Bunnings

Pyrethrum - I suspect we have a couple of outbreaks of this very noxious weed (opposite the tip gates, the area just down from the first Creekline Crossing). Mal Steen/d? Weeds Officer from TRC has been asked to meet at the park to check out.

Jeff has found out it now not. It is Bishops Weed.

Trueyard Brushcutter - I've noticed that after a 10 minutes of use, it starts to performance poorly. Also if you tip it sharply to the side whilst operating, it sputters for a while and stops. Could someone have a quick look at the motor to see if there is any obvious issues. (To leave it at Tam Chainsaw & Mowers, it would be 4 weeks turn around)

Jeff to arrange a service. Jeff to purchase spare air cleaners

Shipping Containers Louvers- the Tractor and the first containers - I have fitted to a door 2 louvered air vents (up high & Low) to both containers. This should allow for some circulation of hot air within the containers (especially after returning the tractor when it's hot). There is a plan to install some additional vents into the inside wall of the second container to disperse heat and petrol fumes from the Solar system batteries.
