NSW Sport Infrastructure Grants - Jeff
 I would encourage you all to have read through this email and the responses to my call to them regarding our requirements.

There are two emails attached which also need a brief view.

Basically, 'Club Builder' for a fee, will assist us through the process of applying for grants once we and the members have been consulted regarding our Strategic Plans and priorities for improvements at the park.

Whilst speaking to them, their recommendation is that we include a couple of priorities together in our fund requests e.g. the front entrance, sealing carpark, shed to replace two containers, bbQ area etc. We will need to re-visit our strategic plan of works.

I will table this matter at our meeting next week to decide on which way we go forward.

- We need to look at our Strategic Plan and make a list of priorities. No active grants being looked at at this stage. Ross to look at a strategic plan planning session in late October.
- Working Bee suggest a list of areas of attention be tabled and scheduled for working be, with date also to be decided.

- Sponsorship offer from Hogs Breath I will share options following discussions I am having with the owner.
 - o Linley (owner) is offering a discount voucher in return for promo.
 - o The club will not be following through with the sponsorship offer.
- Timing system hire request via New England Mountain Bike Club, for Duval Dam buster 24th September Paul Billings (NEMTB) is requesting hire of the timing box only (no matts, plates etc) with suggested pricing of \$300.00 (this is that they have paid previously from the motorcycle club). He can collect and return the box from Tamworth, and it will be under supervision of the organisers throughout the event.
 - Club agrees to hire box out for \$300
- FYI Ride For The Chopper event is this month starting from Woolgoolga returning to Tamworth over 8 days total event duration no action required.
- Defib
 - o Defib is beeping for pads replacement. \$145 for pads replacement. Ross to replace the pads.
