Conditions Of Entry

- Use the facilities in a safe manner:
 - Ride within your ability - if you are not sure, **DO NOT RIDE IT!**
 - All riders must wear an Australian Standards approved bike helmet.
 - All riders are strongly encouraged to wear gloves, suitable clothing, and enclosed footwear.
 - Please make sure your bike is in good working order and is suitable for the grade of trail you choose to ride.
- This is a bike specific park
 - Pedestrians should give way to cyclists.
 - Cyclists please communicate clearly to pedestrians.
- Mountain Bikes must be ridden only on approved signed trails in the set anticlockwise direction - follow the arrows and stay on track please.
- No riding of trails when wet under any circumstances - our clay based trails are extremely unstable in the wet and will suffer significant damage if used.
- Respect all flora and fauna (users must yield to resident horses).
- Vehicles are not permitted to be driven off road unless approved.
- The lighting of fires is not permitted without a permit and venue management approval.
- No bins are provided; please take your rubbish home.
- No motorised activities permitted in the park, including remote controlled devices.
- Building of new trails or Technical Trail Features is prohibited without approval by the venue management. If you have any good ideas please contact management as we are a community facility and value community input.
- Children must be supervised at all times by an accompanying adult.
- This park is all about getting out, getting active and having fun - please enjoy our park and encourage others to do so.
